FAFSA Appointment Checklist

What you will need at the time of the appointment to complete FAFSA online:

- Student's driver's license number
- Birth date(s) and social security number(s) of student, spouse (if applicable), and parent's (if born after January 1, 1990).
- PIN number if student wants to sign FAFSA electronically.
- Parent must be present with their PIN number (if student is a dependent) and if parent wants to sign electronically.
- Previous year Federal Tax Returns (i.e.: 1040, 1040A,1040EZ), parent's Federal Tax Returns (if student is a dependent).
- All previous year W-2 forms for student and parent (if student is a dependent).
- Untaxed income such as workers compensation.
- Total balance of cash on hand and balances of current savings and checking accounts for student and parent(s)(if student is dependent).
- Documentation of business and/or investment farms (if applicable).
- Alien registration card if student is not a U.S. citizen.

If you do not have the above information that is applicable to you at the time of your scheduled appointment, the appointment will be cancelled.
